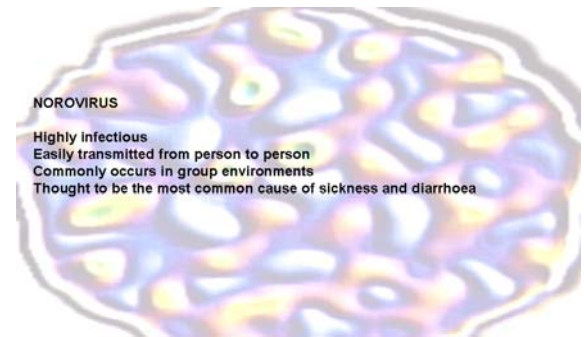

TRANSMISSION & INFECTION

Infected food
Waterborne
Faecal
Person to person
Contact with infected surfaces etc.
Aerosol dispersal
Victim can remain infectious up to 7 days after symptoms



HAND/SURFACE/UTENSIL CONTACT

Inadequate cleaning and disinfection
Poor 'clean-as-you-go' regimes
